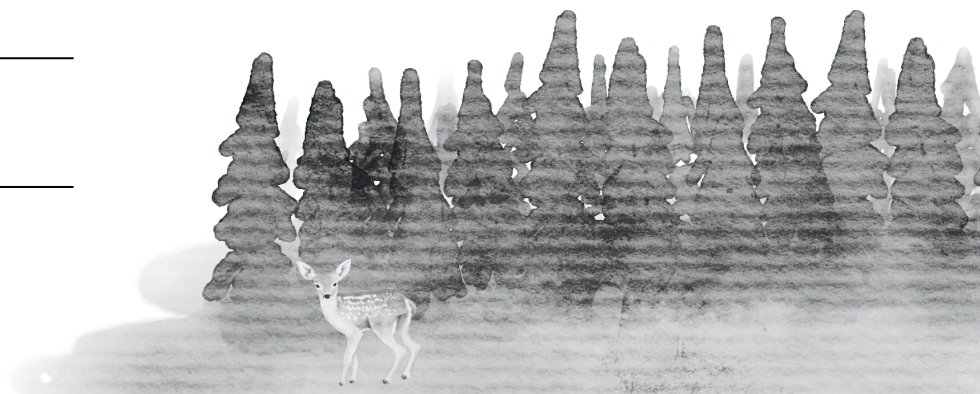

Policies

Code of Conduct

It is expected that kids make their best effort to be kind, courteous, obedient, respectful of property, refraining from foul and rude language and would take part in the activities being provided.

Attendance

Meaningful relationships are best fostered with reliable attendance. Sometimes life comes up, or illness, but we ask that best efforts to attend are made.

Parental Involvement:

Parents are encouraged to be as much a part of the fun as the kids! Drop off may happen if your children are not needing constant redirection. There is a volunteer expectation that will be established once registrations for the term are in and before the term starts.

Estimated that once a month you would stay to help support Rachel in teaching. Parents will take turns rotating bringing fresh fruit to share for snacks. Once a term there is a special electives day where parents can showcase a special skill/passion of theirs to a small group.

Dress Code

This is a casual group. We ask that kids come with appropriate clothes for the weather and any needed safety equipment.

Illness

If kids are visibly sick, feverish, or have a communicable disease we ask that you stay home.

Refund Policy

If you have registered and have changed your mind, you may receive a refund if it is more than 14 days before the start of any programming. After that refunds are only offered on a case by case basis until the start of programming (based on if funds have already been spent in order to best prepare). If you are paying monthly, we ask that you continue to pay for the term you registered for as funds are often already spent. If you have paid for the year in advance and would like to pull out, case by case considerations will be made.
